The hall doors will open at 3.00 pm and there is always a lovely range of food. Please do come along with one plastic bag to fill. We look forward to seeing you then.



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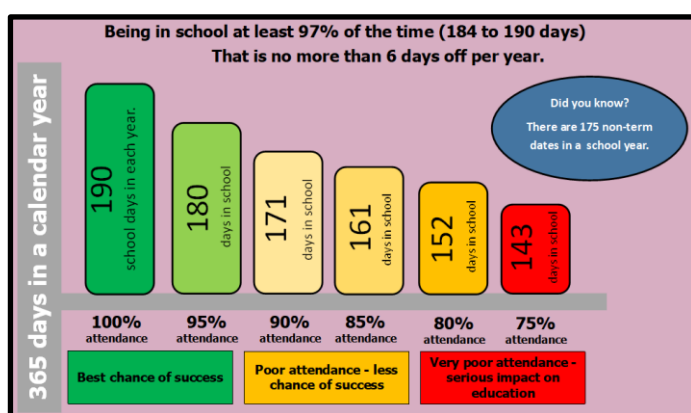


Attendance

BeDifferent Bookworm Reading Incentive

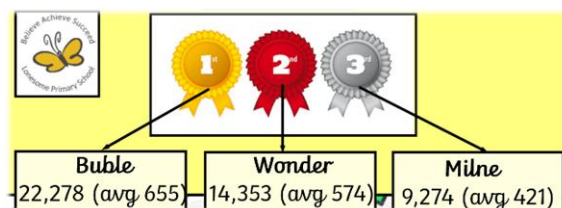
