# **Online Safety: Chatbots and Children**

The social media sphere has recently gained a new tool in their battle for youth engagement- the chatbot. Chat bots are not particularly new but the sophistication of their governing algorithms is. These applications are designed to keep people engaged with artificially generated responses. Responses formulated based on the information the user puts into them. This can create a self-reinforcing effect, where the chatbot continually increases the user's convictions in the truth of their own inputs. False information, reinforcement of poor choices and self-manipulation are common issues with this emerging software.
