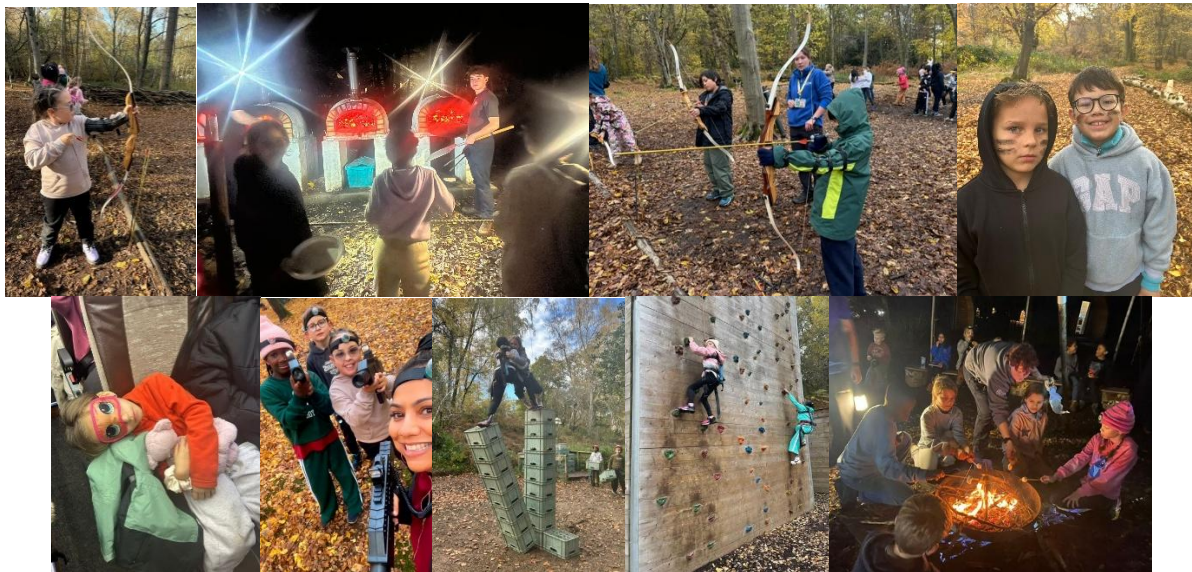
Gather to Give

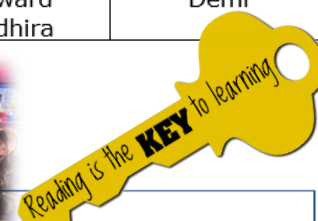
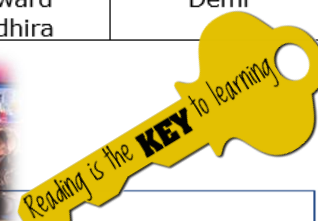
