Strength Lies in Difference

WALT understand what it means to be different and what makes them different from others.

WALT be familiar with these key terms and understand what they mean: Identity, Race, Diverse, Ethnicity, Minority, Majority, Responsibility, Values and Stereotype
WALT understand why it is important to celebrate difference in both themselves and others

Expressive Art and Design

Design and Technology:

WALT Design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria

WALT Select from and use a wide range of materials and components, including construction materials, textiles and ingredients

Music: History of music

WALT Recognise and identify a range of contemporary songs.

WALT Identify what is similar and different about pieces of music or songs.

WALT Begin to understand that popular music changes over time.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

PSHE: What helps us to stay healthy?

WALT Learn what being healthy means and who helps help them to stay healthy (e.g. parent, dentist, doctor)

WALT Know that things people put into or onto their bodies can affect how they feel

WALT Learn how medicines (including vaccinations and immunisations) can help people stay healthy and that some people need to take medicines every day to stay healthy

R.E.: Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?

WALT Empathise with Jewish children by understanding what they do during Shabbat and why it is important to them.

WALT Share favourite days of the week and talk about food children would choose to share in a special meal.

WALT Use the right names for things that are special to Jewish people during Shabbat and explain why they are important.

WALT Make connections between being Jewish and decisions about behaviour.
