Mathematics

Children will develop their skills to ...

Week 1 and 2: identifies and describes the properties of common 2D and 3D shapes, compares and sorts common 2D and 3D shapes and describes position, direction and movement

Week 3: estimate, choose and use standard units of measure for capacity Week 4: estimate, choose and use standard units of measure for weight

Week 5: add and subtract numbers to 100 using a variety of methods, use estimation to check that their answers to a calculation, solve problems with addition and subtraction and use and apply the inverse of addition and subtraction to find missing numbers in calculations

Week 6: recall multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, calculates mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and solve problems involving multiplication and division

Science: Plants: Children will learn to ...

Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

Perform a simple test to find out which seed will make Grandma shrink faster by observing if all seeds germinate in the same way

Research how Jan Ingenhousz discovered how plants need light to grow.
