Listening and attention

WALT: Listen to stories and retell them in different ways- Stories and songs from other countries; Story telling using props

Understanding

WALT Use a range on non- fiction text and photographs to learn about the way of life of people in other countries-Memory games - 'I went to market and I bought...'; Holiday photos from abroad; Bedouin Tent, Inuit igloo, market stall from another country, sari shop-describing and talking confidently about different items from around the World.

WALT: Extend children's vocabulary, exploring the meanings and sounds of new words. Use language to

imagine and recreate roles and experiences- Collect artefacts from around the world - Russian dolls, African drums or masks, bells, sari material etc. Tell stories of journeys using these props; Book making; Story telling with props and puppets

WALT: Use a range of reading text to learn about: jobs people do-who works at the airport? ; Transport and ways of travelling around the World; Stories and traditional tales around the World

WALT: Learn to say 'hello' in different languages

Writing

WALT: To write for different purposes- Chinese writing; Make up a global alphabet using words associated with other countries; postcards from around the World; write posters, signs and menus in different languages.

Mathematics

Numbers

WALT: Count forwards in 2's 5's 10's and backwards -from 30

WALT: Use ordinal numerals to show position - Sports Day results - Who came 1st, 2nd ...

Shape Space and measure

WALT: learn about the different currencies used in different countries

Sorting coins activity - Which coins/notes are used in England?

WALT: Use money to pay for food for cooking activities - Role play or real shopping trip to buy resources for cooking activities

Use pennies during shopping role play- How many pennies should I count out for this item?

WALT: -Measure quantities using weight - Cooking activities - for dishes from around the world -Weigh ingredients using weighing scales - . Which ingredient is heaviest/ lightest

WALT: Measure length using non- standard measure- Problem solving activities - How long is my foot? Is it longer than my friends?

Use construction materials to build models of landmark from different countries e.g. Eiffel tower/ Big Ben/Tower of Pisa. How tall can I build my chosen landmark?

WALT: learn about practical experiences linked to families and their home countries.- Family guest speakers to classes
