# **Expressive Art and Design**

#### **Art: Painting**

## **Understanding of the World**

#### Geography: Egypt and the River Nile

WALT locate some of the world's countries, concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries and major cities.

WALT describe and understand key aspects of physical geography – rivers.

WALT describe and understand key aspects of human geography – types of land use, distribution of natural resources (energy).

#### **History: Ancient Egypt**

WALT learn about the achievement of the earliest civilisations – an overview of where and when the first civilisations appeared and a depth study of Ancient Egypt

#### Science: Forces

WALT explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object

WALT identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, which act between moving surfaces

WALT recognise that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect
