

## Knowledge Outcomes

The USA, Canada and Mexico are the largest 3 countries in the continent of North America. The Atlantic Ocean lays to the East of North America and the Pacific Ocean lays to the West. The capital city of the USA is Washington DC. North America stretches across the four main climate zones of the world – polar, temperate, sub-tropics and tropical.

The landscape of North America is extremely varied – there are mountains, deserts, plains, glaciers, rainforests and waterfalls.

**Challenge:** The Rocky Mountains stretch approximately 3000 miles through Canada and the USA.

### PSCHE: How do we manage risk in different places?

WALT Understand, recognise, predict, assess and manage risk in different situations
