Pupil premium in Year 2 have performed better than non-pupil premium children in reading and Mathematics at ARE+. Non-pupil premium children have performed better than Pupil Premium children in writing (12% better) and in the percentage of children working at greater depth in all areas.



Pupil premium children have made better progress than non-pupil premium children in writing and Mathematics. 6% less pupil premium children have made expected progress in reading compared to non-pupil premium children.

Pupil premium in Year 6 have not performed as well as non-pupil premium children in reading and writing. A greater percentage of non-pupil premium children are working above age related than Pupil Premium children.

Pupil premium children have made less progress than non-pupil premium children in reading and writing. However, progress of Pupil Premium children in Mathematics is only 2% lower than that of non-Pupil Premium children.
